ALEXANDER INVADED THE PERSIAN EMPIRE AND CONQUERED ITS GREAT CITIES (SUSA AND PERSEPOLIS), FINALLY DEFEATING DARIUS III AT THE BATTLE OF GAUGAMELA (331 BC)



ALEXANDER RETURNS

REACHED PRESENT-DAY PAKISTAN TO STRENGTHEN AFTER CONQUERING PERSIA, THE MACEDONIA PHALANX. THEN HIS CONQUEST, ALEXANDER MARRIED ROSANA, A PAKISTANI PRINCESS.
